Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

Conflict Minerals, as defined by the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, are:

- Columbine – Tantalite (Tantalum)
- Cassiterite (Tin)
- Wolframite (Tungsten)
- Gold

Marmon Aerospace & Defense does not use any conflict minerals in their raw form. Tin, however, is used as a plating material over bare copper to make un-insulated Conductors. Marmon Aerospace & Defense uses this kind of un-insulated conductor in a number of its products, and it purchases such un-insulated conductor from a variety of suppliers. Our conductor suppliers have supplied written statements to us that they do not use conflict minerals in their products. Therefore, to the best of our knowledge, Marmon Aerospace & Defense does not use conflict minerals in our products or our manufacturing processes.
