Ricky Pfeil Comments

I am absolutely convinced (fully persuaded to use the Bible's description of Abraham) that the Word of God is true, accurate, infallible and totally clear that God wants us all to be healed. I hold the position that it is impossible for the Word of God to be wrong or false on any subject. I have known people who believed that God's Word promised them healing and they quoted the Word, sometimes even putting Scriptures up on the wall in their sick room. But, they died. Now, I certainly know others who received outstanding miracle recoveries that cannot be explained any other way than that it was a complete miracle.

The doctrinal position that is commonly or usually taken by most Christians is that regardless of what the Scriptures say, God is Sovereign and that it was His choice to take certain people by some awful disease, often at an age far too young. I am convinced that that conclusion is a serious error because it is impossible for God to lie. It is not impossible for us humans to miss something in our battles that results in us coming up short of the promises.

I am not saying this to reflect any kind of disrespect or dishonor to wonderful saints of God who fought a good fight to the best of their knowledge and with all their hearts. Thank God, these people are in Heaven and are not sad or disappointed at being there.

But, we must be honest and acknowledge that God never lies, and He never has a plan for someone that is contradictory to His written Word or that is contrary to the provision of Calvary. So, the thing we must do is NOT focus on why some people died without having received the fulfillment of the clearly declared promises of God. We, frankly, don't know everything about everybody and their battles. But, I do know that it is impossible for God to lie and that if He didn't want us all to be healed, He would not have said the things He said that are recorded in the Bible.

So, we are committed to continue proclaiming the stated truths of God's Word and encouraging people to keep pressing in to the Word and laying hold of those promises. The Word of God doesn't change based on anybody's specific experience. Something unknown to us can be missed on the human side, but nothing is amiss on God's side of these things. We would be wise to hold fast to God's Word and resolve in our hearts and minds to not be deterred from the Word because we don't understand some situations. Don't make up things that are not supported by the Scriptures just to give yourself some kind of false comfort. Space prevents me from sharing all these comments and also sharing Scripture references, but there are many Scriptures to share, and I have shared them in numerous teaching series on the subject of healing. The provision of your healing is in the Word.
