Ricky Pfeil Comments

There is a very significant part of a David Ingles' song that should always be remembered if you are interested in living in victory, in health, and in the fullness of God's blessings. The portion of the song that I'm referencing is "Don't think it's not important what you say, 'cause today, you're the total of your talking yesterday". Sadly, most Christians know little, or nothing, about this.

The Bible has much to say about what we say. In Proverbs 18:21, the Word of God says that death and life are in the power of the tongue. Which are you speaking continuously? I'm not talking about magic. I'm not talking about being goofy. I'm not teaching that "saying things" is all there is to it. But, we must have a disciplined tongue. In James 3:2, the Word says that if we don't stumble in words we speak, we would be a perfect (meaning fully mature) person, and it says that our uncontrolled spoken words set on fire the entire course of our existence. Jesus said that we could move mountains if we would say to them to be removed, and didn't doubt that what we say will come to pass. That's in Mark 11:23.

God said in Hebrews 11:3 that the worlds were framed by the spoken word (rhema) of God. **Framed**, in the Greek word from which it was translated, literally means to "complete thoroughly, repair, or adjust". Our world (the realm of life in which we live) is adjusted, or repaired by the words we consistently say over ourselves and our circumstances. What are you talking about all the time? Do you constantly talk of your troubles, negative circumstances, and "aches and pains"? Do you speak out your fears, or do you talk faith (that is, "agreement with the Word of God")?

There are many negative things said about "positive confession". But, the Word says to hold fast to our confession of faith in Hebrews 10:23. "Confession" ("profession" KJV rendering) actually means to "say the same thing". You might be amazed at how much better life would be, and how adjusted everything would become, if you took these verses I've referenced to heart. God told Joshua that he would make his way prosperous and have good success if he would (1) keep **speaking** the Word of God (don't let it depart from being what you speak), (2) **meditate** in the Word day and night, and (3) **observe to do** what the Word says. (Joshua 1:8) Jesus said, **For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks. A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good things, and an evil man out of the evil treasure brings forth evil things. But I say to you that for every idle word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment. For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned."**
