There may be some people who disagree with the writing of James in the Bible. We don't get saved by works, but if you have no corresponding works, it is obvious that you aren't saved. You will be known by the fruit you bear, or the works you do. Look at the Word of God through James:

- Jas 2:14 What does it profit, my brethren, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can faith save him?
- Jas 2:15 If a brother or sister is naked and destitute of daily food,
- Jas 2:16 and one of you says to them, "Depart in peace, be warmed and filled," but you do not give them the things which are needed for the body, what does it profit?
- Jas 2:17 Thus also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead.
- Jas 2:18 But someone will say, "You have faith, and I have works." Show me your faith without your works, and I will show you my faith by my works.
- Jas 2:19 You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe—and tremble!
- Jas 2:20 But do you want to know, O foolish man, that faith without works is dead?
- Jas 2:21 Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered Isaac his son on the altar?
- Jas 2:22 Do you see that faith was working together with his works, and by works faith was made perfect?
- Jas 2:23 And the Scripture was fulfilled which says, "ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS ACCOUNTED TO HIM FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS." And he was called the friend of God.
- Jas 2:24 You see then that a man is justified by works, and not by faith only.

Works cannot not make you born again. You cannot "earn" salvation. Though you aren't saved by works, you are absolutely saved to work. Note these Scriptures:

- 2Cor 5:9 Therefore we make it our aim, whether present or absent, to be well pleasing to Him.
- 2Cor 5:10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.

We will be judged when we appear before God in Heaven according to what we HAVE DONE after being saved.

- Joh 5:28 Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His voice
- Joh 5:29 and come forth—those who have done good, to the resurrection of

life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of condemnation.

This statement is from the mouth of the very person who gave His life that we might be saved. In the end, we will be judged according to what we have done.

Heb 4:11 Let us labor therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.
