Ricky Pfeil Comments

Mark 11:24 says, "Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them."

I believe that most Christians don't believe that verse, but they won't just bluntly say they don't believe it. When I was a child, and even as a teenager, I would hear older saints in the churches say, "God said He meets our needs, but He never promised to give us our wants." As a kid, I thought they were right because I figured they knew what they were talking about. However, I now can see that either they didn't actually read the Bible, or they read it and refused to believe it because it just sounds too good to be true, or it sounds like it's more than Jesus would really want for us. However, the Lord knows how to say what He means. There is no need for us to correct Jesus or try to word it better than He did.

"What things soever ye desire" is definitely a promise from Jesus that is more than just your bare necessities. He said on another occasion, "And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive." (Matthew 21:22) Do we believe this? He said, "all things whatsoever you shall ask believing". Believing is the key. I'll give you one more Scripture reference, it's in John 15:7. "If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you."

I think you are just like me in your heart. I believe that you desire to please God and wouldn't want anything that would destroy you, hinder you, or turn you away from God. We need to broaden our expectancy. We also need to realize that God actually really truly loves us. John said in 1 John 3:1 to **Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us.** He wants you and me to be **blessed exceedingly above what we can ask or think**. Don't take my word for it, see that in Ephesians 3:20. Jesus would ask people who came to Him, "What do you want," or "if you can believe, you can have what you desire". (See examples in Mark 10:51 and Mark 9:23).

God is waiting for us to ask. Abraham was afraid he was going to anger God by asking repeatedly lowering the number of righteous people in Sodom needed to spare the city, but there is no hint in the Scripture that God was annoyed in the least at Abraham's repeated asking. Look at this: **Jeremiah 33:3, "Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and shew thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not."**

Maybe, instead of putting up with things we don't want, such as financial lack, an unpleasant low-paying job, aches and pains, and a plethora of other things that make life miserable, we should take God seriously about asking things we desire of Him. Go ahead, ask something of God today, and start praising Him for it.
