Many Christians believe, talk, and sing about how rough life is. Songs say such things as "Tempted and tried, I'm oft made to wonder why it must be thus all the day long", or "As I travel through this **weary land**, there's a friend that walks with me," or "Sometimes I feel discouraged and think my life in vain." I could fill the page with more, but why do so many Christians completely ignore Scriptures that say something different?

There are many verses in your Bible that say clearly that God wants things to go well with you. He wants you to "lie down in green pastures". He wants your "cup running over". He wants "goodness and mercy" following you all the days of your life. But, most Christians would rather talk about being another Job suffering loss, or being like Paul with a thorn in the flesh. They overlook the fact that though Paul suffered many persecutions, he never said he was sick or almost blind. In other words, he didn't suffer things that were suffered for us by Jesus at the cross, delivering us from sins and sicknesses. They also apparently forget that Job, who was the richest man in the East before his trials (which lasted less than a year), had twice as much wealth when the trials were over and lived an additional 140 years.

Most Christians have much more sorrow, sickness, and tragedy than they have to, and many of the problems are self-induced, having nothing to do with persecution for the faith. The tongue is one of the major things that put negative and destructive things in motion. In other words, more troubles than we realize are "tongue troubles". We need to learn to speak the Word over ourselves repeatedly, saying as the woman did with Elisha, "all is well" based on the Word. She said that when her child had died and she went to get Elisha, who came and raised him from the dead.

SAY WHAT THE WORD SAYS OVER AND OVER. It says God wants things to go well with you. (Check the Word because I can't write them all into this article. Look at Deut. 4:39-40, Jeremiah 29:11, John 10:10, Ephesians 6:2-3, Deut. 6:18, Deut. 12:28, and Psalm 128:1-2.) Believe me, there are more.

The Lord said to Joshua that if he would keep the Word <u>in his mouth</u> and <u>in his mind</u> (meditate therein day and night), and <u>in his actions</u> (observe to do what is written), he would have <u>prosperity</u> and <u>good success</u>. The Word says we are more than conquerors through Christ. It even says that all things will work together for our good.
