Ricky Pfeil Comments

When I was a child, I daydreamed often about being on the radio. When I was in elementary school, I pretended that I was announcing to an audience the things we were studying in class (my pen was my imaginary mic.) As I grew older, I pretended that I was announcing to people who were listening as I played records on Mom's record player. I had a huge disliking of school, but we didn't know anything about Christian schools in the '50's and '60's. So, the only two days I remember enjoying school were days we took a field trip to a radio station. That happened once in elementary school and once in the 9th grade.

I didn't know how to make dreams come true. I just knew I loved radio, and I loved talking, and I loved gospel music. In December of 1969, I was doing some part time end-of-the-year inventory work for a man whose name was Tom Cole at his Christian book and music store. He asked if I would be interested in working at the Christian radio station in Canyon. I said, "Yes". I still see him, in my mind, walking over to the phone and calling to set up an appointment for me to talk to the station owner. He hired me.

My dream began to come true, but seven months later, I was fired from that job. The door slammed shut, but the dream did not go away. The fire had been ignited. I approached another station and offered to bring some Christian programs to their station and was on the air with them within a couple of weeks. I was the DJ on that station for two hours daily, six days a week, until they decided five months later that they didn't want that. It was enjoyable while it lasted. However, my dream had seemingly ended abruptly twice within thirteen months.

Someday, I will write a book and fill in more details, but I will make it brief here. In May of 1976, the Lord impressed upon my heart that in taking the position of Pastor in Wheeler, Texas, radio would be a big part of it. And, it was. I approached the nearest radio station, and was on the air for nine years in Shamrock. Then, KPDR went on the air without a gap. My program on that Shamrock station was on for the last time on Aug. 30, 1986. The next day, we began KPDR in Wheeler, and have been on ever since. (Six days after the last program in Shamrock, that station went off the air forever).

At the time, I did not anticipate other stations or translators. Later, Wheeler got approval to increase to 10,000 watts, and we added translators in Pampa and Canadian. As time went along, we got to the current network of 8 stations and 6 translators, and Wheeler's station is now an 80,000 watt station.

It reminds me of an old song that says "God specializes in things thought impossible." Our hearts overflow with gratitude for the privilege of seeing a childhood dream fulfilled far beyond my imagination. Only God knows how much more is ahead, but we are excited to be on this road touching people and contributing our part to the Kingdom of God. I wouldn't take nothing for my journey now.

We will have one of our two annual "Partnership Information and Fund-raising Days" on May 7-9. Your prayers are requested as we approach those days.

The antennas have arrived ! We are still waiting for the tower crew on the installation. Hopefully, it will be soon and we will have greater outreach with the signal of KJRT here in Amarillo.
