There are many Christians that believe that healing is rare, and that the correct way to pray is "Lord, if it be thy will, heal me (or whomever they are praying for)." It strikes me as a strange thing that this kind of praying gets little, or no results, convincing people that it isn't God's will, no matter how many Scriptures you give them describing God's clearly revealed will, and that He has healed us and desires that we live in health. These people come to the conclusion that it isn't, or must not be, His will. Then, they proceed to take medication, or get medical treatment, or surgery contrary to God's "so called" will.

Have you ever stopped to consider that people won't be getting healed in Heaven because there is never any sickness there, nor anything that causes sickness to be healed of? The Bible does say in the 22nd chapter of Revelation that the tree of life in Heaven bears twelve fruits, each tree yielding its fruit every month, and that the leaves of the tree are for the healing of the nations. Notice, the leaves of the tree are not for the healing of the people who live in Heaven. They are for the healing of the nations. The next verse says that there shall be no more curse in Heaven. Since sickness is shown to be related to the curse in the Bible, there is no sickness in Heaven to be healed of.

The point I'm trying to make here is that healing is for us <u>in this life</u>, not after we get to Heaven. Yet, many Christians don't believe that. They believe God could heal, but many times doesn't choose to. But, God said the choice is ours, not His. "I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live." (Deut. 30:19).

Healing of the physical body is part of our covenant provisions in this life. So, it's for now, not for the sweet by and by. Therefore, lay hold of it. Praise God for it. Quit insulting God by praying that He heal you "if it be Thy will" and then while assuming it isn't, rebelling against His supposed will by getting medical assistance to get healing anyway. Almost everyone goes to the doctor and takes prescribed medicine from the doctor without ever praying whether it's the will of God to try to get well. But, if it is not God's will for you to get well, why would you ask for help from the doctor?

Almost all Christians accept strongly that it is God's will that they be born again. They will tell you the Bible says so. Well, the Bible says that healing is provided for us and health is God's will. We would be glad to give you a list of numerous Scriptures for the asking. Why do so many strongly believe the Scriptures about "getting born again", but are resistant to the healing Scriptures? God said, "I am the Lord that healeth **thee"**, and He said "by His stripes we are healed".
