

Comments from Ricky Pfeil

As I sit to write this message to all who receive our newsletter, I ponder how thankful I am for you. The word “ponder” caught my attention in a stronger way than I ever remember during the Christmas season. The Bible said in Luke 2:10, regarding the things that the shepherds had told her about what they had seen and heard from the angels, that Mary kept these things and pondered them in her heart. Ponder means “to weigh in the mind” or “to deeply consider”.

Why am I pondering how grateful I am for you? I'll explain briefly. When we began this ministry over 39 years ago, we had numerous ministries that put their radio programs on the air and paid monthly for that. That was greatly needed and very much appreciated. But, things are not the same today as they were four decades ago. Most of the local and area churches stopped producing radio programs. Several of the Pastors and other preachers died, or moved away. And, one by one, the National ministries (such as John Hagee, David Jeremiah, Joyce Meyer, and more) whose radio bill brought a nice amount of finances monthly, stopped all radio broadcasting nationwide.

Nowadays, there are a few ministries that pay for a program. Many of the programs are aired for the spiritual benefit of the listeners, but without payment from the ministry they represent (Kenneth Hagin, Keith Moore, Point of View, and several more). Others share a portion of contributions sent to them from our listeners only when they receive contributions (Southwest Radio Church, James Dobson Ministries, Adrian Rogers, for example).

My point is that the majority of the finances needed to function (about \$400,000 annually) come from individual listeners. I would estimate that somewhere between two-thirds, and three-fourths, of the funds come from individual people, such as many of you who are reading this. My heart is flooded with thanksgiving as I ponder the numerous times this year that Linda has told me of large contributions that came in the mail.

The times and circumstances, and sources through which funds come, may have all changed, but God changes not. He raised this ministry up, and He keeps it going. I believe it is miraculous. Thanks, everybody, and Happy New Year.
