

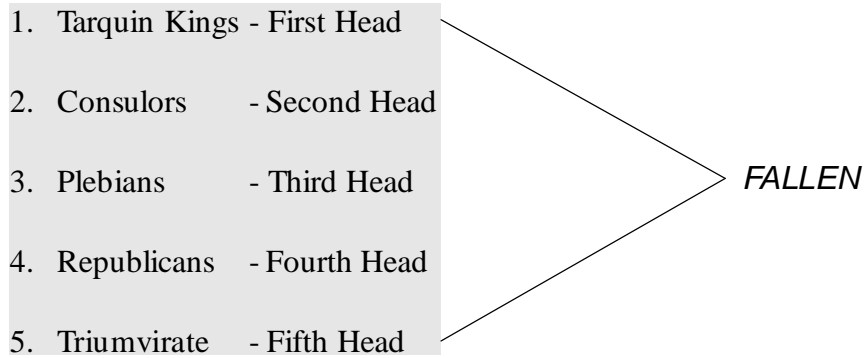

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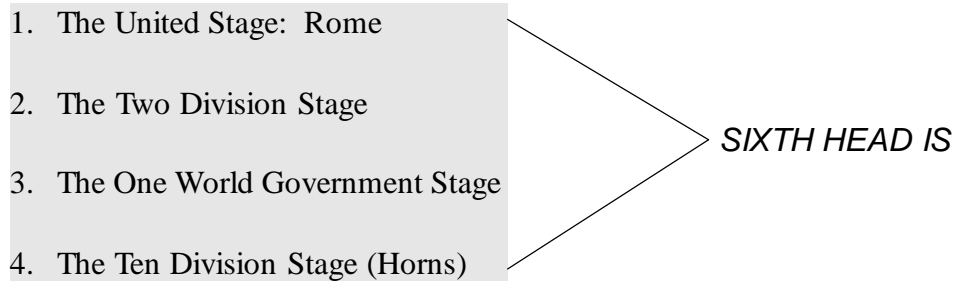

- a. World War I of Tribulation: Rises to Power
- b. World War II of Tribulation
 - (1) Killed
 - (2) Resurrected
 - (3) Kills three kings and seven kings submit
 - (4) Rules world for 3½ years
- c. World War III of Tribulation - Killed by Christ

POSSIBLE RECKONINGS CONCERNING THE DECREE OF ARTAXERXES TO NEHEMIAH

A. Sir Robertson Anderson - A.D. 32 crucifixion

1. $69 \times 7 \times 360 = 173,880$ days
2. Lunar reckoning (March 14, 445 B.C. until April 6, A.D. 32) - Triumphal Entry
3. Solar year conversion

445 B.C. - A.D. 32	=	476 years
476 x 365	=	173,740 days
Leap years	=	116 days
March 14 - April 6	=	24 days

B. Harold Horner - A.D. 33 crucifixion

1. $69 \times 7 \times 360 = 173,880$ days
2. Lunar reckoning (March 4, 444 B.C. until March 29, A.D. 33) - Triumphal Entry
3. Solar year conversion

444 B.C. - A.D. 33	=	476 years
476 x 365	=	173,740 days
Leap years	=	116 days
March 6 - 29	=	24 days
