

### About FairPoint Communications

July 3, 2017 – Consolidated Communications merges with FairPoint Communications



9<sup>th</sup> Largest Fiber Provider - spanning 36,000 fiber route miles

### FairPoint in Maine

- Increased broadband availability from 67% to 90% in our service area
- Expanded broadband to more than 300 communities and 75,000 homes and businesses
- More than 900 employees in 238+ Maine communities
  - From Eastport to Bethel and Fort Kent to Kittery
  - We're local...

### FairPoint's Network

- Our next-generation Ethernet network is ubiquitous across Maine, NH and Vermont.
- FairPoint's network has nearly18,000 total miles of fiber.
- It's the region's largest fully-owned and managed fiber-based network.
- Our 24/7/365 Network Operations Center ensures our network stays connected around the clock.
- We deliver 99.999% core network availability.

### What Is CAF II

- <u>Connect America Fund II</u> is the federal governments plan to deliver broadband to hard to reach, rural areas.
- FairPoint has elected to take the \$13.3 million of annual funding in Maine, for six years.
- FairPoint has six years to complete the build-out to the required 35,500 locations.
- FairPoint agrees to provide broadband services at a speed of (10/1) to unserved locations as determined by the FCC.
- CAF II requires:
  - broadband internet with speeds of 10/1 Mbps,
  - latency of less than 100 milliseconds,
  - data of at least 100 Gig per month, and
  - Pricing in CAF II areas that is reasonably comparable to pricing in urban areas.

### Incremental Milestones

- 40 percent of the CAF II build-out must be completed by the end of 2017;
- 60 percent of the build-out must be completed by the end of 2018; and,
- 100 percent of the build-out must be completed by the end of 2020.

# Current Progress

- 204 projects complete
- 20 projects construction complete
- 80 projects in construction
- 99 projects in engineering
- FairPoint's next CAF filing is October 2017; FairPoint expects to report over 34% complete
- FairPoint is on track to exceed the 40% commitment by year end
