*One lightning talk monthly meetup attracted ~100 attendees!*



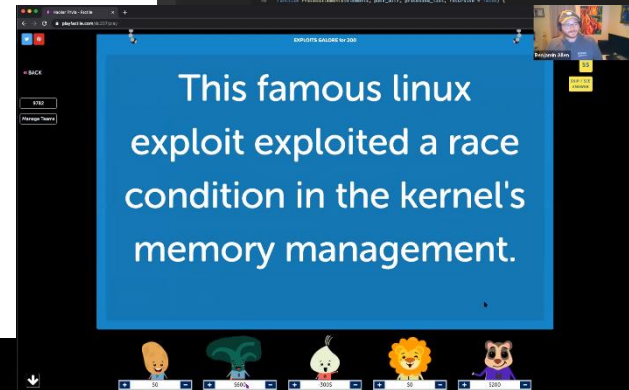
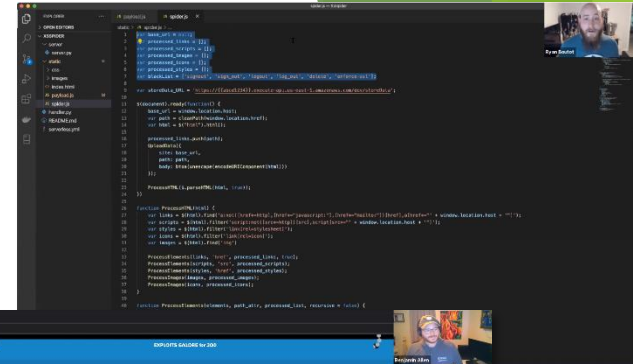
# DC207 (DefCon207)
