While this Executive Order did not contain any specific provisions relating to evictions, it directed certain governmental agencies to initiate efforts to both consider and address the potential issues arising from evictions. Based on this authority, the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has now issued an Agency Order entitled the “Temporary Halt in Residential Evictions to Prevent the Further Spread of COVID-19” (hereinafter, the “Order”). In summary, this Order prohibits all evictions for non-payment of rent until December 31, 2020 for tenants who verify certain information relating to an inability to pay rent. While this Executive Order did not contain any specific provisions relating to evictions, it directed certain governmental agencies to initiate efforts to both consider and address the potential issues arising from evictions. Based on this authority, the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has now issued an Agency Order entitled the “Temporary Halt in Residential Evictions to Prevent the Further Spread of COVID-19” (hereinafter, the “Order”). In summary, this Order prohibits all evictions for non-payment of rent until December 31, 2020 for tenants who verify certain information relating to an inability to pay rent.
