The inventory import file used by The Uniform Solution must be in a Windows compatible file format that is a comma delimited file (csv). All fields marked as required ("Y") must provided or the record will not be imported. **Discontinued items should NOT be included in the file.**

Primary Category	Secondary Category Examples
Jackets & Outerwear	Jacket, Lab Coats, Fleece, Coat, Rainwear, Vest, Sweater, Hoodie, Fleece, etc.
Tops & Shirts	Polo Shirt, T-Shirt, Woven Shirt, Base Layers, Solid Top, Print Top, Knit Top, Tuck in Top, Underscrub etc.
Pants & Bottoms	Pant, Cargo, Trouser, Straight Leg, Slim Leg, Wide Leg, Joggers, Flare Leg, Tapered Leg, Leggings, Drawstring, Elastic Waist, High Waisted, Skirt, Dresses, Short, etc.
Footwear	Boots, Shoe, Socks, Insoles, Clogs, Sandals, Slip-ons, Slippers, etc.
