Tenacre's Archivist and Researcher Kelly Byquist explained to the audience that former Tenacre President Burwell Harrison, who ran Tenacre for 50 years, had inherited a facility that was disreputable, broken, and near bankruptcy. Seeley came into Harrison's life just when he needed it most and introduced him to a new way of thinking.

Tenacre's archives contain about 25 letters written between Seeley and Harrison that span nearly 40 years. These letters have been a help to Tenacre through the decades. Here is one excerpt from those letters:

"It is necessary to realize that there are, in the light of Science, not many businesses, nor are there many human persons. The fact, is that there is one Person, the infinite I Am, and this one Person is expressed by all identities and governs them all." (Paul Stark Seeley to Burwell Harrison, February 27, 1962)
