Hog Hunt Rules

- 1. Entry fee is \$200 per team. 100% of the profits will go toward the Franklin County Chamber of Commerce. Your registration fee is tax deductible. Your team may pay an extra \$80 for the "Monster Hog" pot to be split 50/50 between the winning team and Franklin County Chamber of Commerce.
- 2. All entry fees must be paid in full by Noon, on Friday, March 26, 2021. NO EXCEPTIONS

- 3. A "team" will consist of 1, 2, 3 or 4 people.
- 4. All "teams" must stay together while hunting. Teams are not allowed to split while hunting. Team members MUST consist of the individuals originally designated on the entry permit and cannot change at any point during the hunt.
- 5. The hunt will begin at 3pm (NOT BEFORE) on Friday March 26, 2021. On Saturday March 27, you MUST check-in at Tom Scott Lumber with your hogs by 3pm or you will not be allowed to enter your kill. It is suggested that you arrive a bit early.
- 6. Participants are responsible for securing their own hunting locations.
- 7. Participants are responsible for disposing of their own kill.
- 8. All hogs must be <u>SHOT</u> during the designated contest time limits. All calibers and gauges are acceptable. <u>NO TRAPPING</u> of any sort will be allowed. No previously trapped and penned animals will be allowed. All animals checked in by a team must have been killed by that team. <u>NO SHARING OF ANIMALS</u>. This Hunt was created in the spirit of <u>FAIR COMPETITION</u> and cheating of any sort will not be tolerated. We realize that the HUNT cannot be policed and cheating cannot be proven, but <u>IF YOU ARE SUSPECTED OF CHEATING</u>, <u>YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED</u>.
- 9. Winners may be subject to polygraph test.
- 10. Questionable animals may be skinned to check for signs that they were killed prior to the designated hunt or by any manner other than being **SHOT. NO ROADKILL.**
- 11. <u>ALL</u> team members must have a <u>current hunting license</u>. Remember, you are subject to being checked by a GAME WARDEN at any time during the Hunt. <u>MUST FOLLOW ALL COUNTY, STATE AND FEDERAL HUNTING LAWS</u>. IF YOU ARE UNDER THE AGE OF 18, you MUST have a parent or guardian sign a notarized form and you MUST HUNT with an adult.
- 12. 1st PLACE HOG HUNT will consist of greatest total hog count. In the event of more than one team with the same total hog count, each team will choose one hog of their choice to be weighed. The team with the largest single hog by weight will be determined the winner.
- 13. 2nd and 3rd PLACE will be determined by the total amount of hogs killed. If there should be a tie in total amount of hogs killed, each team will choose one hog of their choice to be weighed. The team with the largest single hog by weight will be determined the 2nd place winner. The team with the second largest hog by weight will be determined the 3rd place winner.
- 14. The "Monster Hog" is a separate contest and will pay 50% of the monies collected for that specific hunt. The team is responsible for choosing their single hog to be weighed. The team does not have to place to win the "Monster Hog" challenge.
