Summary: Participates in the healing Mission and Ministry of Tenacre by cleaning the Christian Science Nursing settings, visitor and resident accommodations, offices, and other property-wide areas. A successful housekeeper at Tenacre strives to clean and tidy with love and grace and should be cheerful, orderly, punctual, and patient.

Team Player: Works safely and cooperatively with a team toward the accomplishment of shared goals.

Integrity and Ethics: Makes decisions and acts with Tenacre's long-term interests in mind; is a good listener and approaches work from a thoughtful and caring basis; demonstrates reliability, including punctuality.

Attention to Detail: Is thorough in accomplishing tasks no matter how small; monitors and checks work; plans and organizes time and resources efficiently even under the pressure of multiple demands.

Immediacy and Flexibility: Willingness to work on any scheduled assignment. Enjoys working hard; can be counted on to get things done on time; adapts quickly to changing needs and schedules.

Judgment: Gets questions answered from appropriate sources; is flexible and adaptable to new priorities and ideas; uses initiative appropriately.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities; other duties may be assigned.

- Daily reads checklist for work assignment; anticipates and gathers necessary supplies for the job and takes these to the site to be cleaned
- Safely uses the right equipment and chemicals to clean various campus spaces, including offices, cottages, staff housing, visitor accommodations, common spaces, kitchens, bathrooms, and outdoor areas

- Operates professional laundry machines in the Tenacre Main Laundry and use cleaning detergents accurately; regularly sort and count linens for delivery to other areas; occasionally climbs a ladder to stack laundry in the closets
- Visually inspects work areas and maintains various housekeeping closets
- Safely and properly moves and/or carries housekeeping equipment, occasionally lifting items weighing up to 25 pounds
- Walks throughout the multi-acre property in various weather conditions, climbs stairs when necessary, and works in any of the buildings
- Once trained, drives the utility cart safely throughout the Tenacre property
- Work in the Christian Science Nursing settings as scheduled
- Agrees to work on rotating weekend schedule and shows flexibility to Department requests to cover cleaning needs that arise unexpectedly
