Summary: Participates in the Mission and Ministry of Tenacre by performing various manual tasks in the inspection, maintenance and repair of Tenacre's buildings, facilities and mechanical equipment. Familiar with a variety of the field's concepts, practices, and procedures. Works with staff and residents in a spirit of cooperation that is supportive of the healing atmosphere at Tenacre.

Competencies: To perform the job successfully, an individual should demonstrate the following competencies:

Integrity and Ethics:

Makes decisions and acts with Tenacre's long term interests in mind; is a good listener and approaches work from a basis that is thoughtful and caring; maintains the highest ethical standards; handles confidential information responsibly; is well versed in Tenacre's safety programs, procedures, policies and consistently follows them; makes tough decisions to ensure that safety remains front and center.

Attention to Detail:

Is thorough and skillful in accomplishing a variety of tasks which range from complicated to minor in nature; monitors and checks work; plans and organizes time and resources efficiently even under the pressure of multiple demands.

Team Player:

Works cooperatively with others toward accomplishment of a shared goal; leverages own strengths and demonstrates understanding of weaknesses in order to most effectively contribute to a project; knows when to lead and when to follow; reinforces the team concept through all actions.

Demonstrates a Sense of Immediacy and Flexibility:

Sets high expectations and achieves them regardless of the barriers; demonstrates a passion for one's work - enjoys working hard and is full of energy; can be counted on to get things done on time and with excellent quality and results; adapts quickly, based on Tenacre's changing needs.

Judgment: Gets questions answered from appropriate sources; is flexible and adaptable to new priorities and ideas, uses initiative appropriately

Apply Functional Knowledge: Relies on experience and judgment to plan and accomplish goals. Uses a wide degree of critical thinking, creativity and latitude to problem-solve. Obtains an appropriate level of professional skill and knowledge to keep up with current developments in relevant areas. Learns this information and skills quickly.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities; other duties may be assigned

- Reports directly to the Maintenance Supervisor and follows through on all delegated tasks and projects
- Supports others in the B&G shop cleaning, organization, and overall support of all activities within the shop
- Assists in the delivery and pick-up of vehicles taken off campus for service work
- Provides support in material pick-up services from local supply shops
- Supports other technicians in completing work order requests in a caring and timely manner and with a level of quality consistent with departmental standards
- Performs a variety of preventative maintenance tasks such as cleaning, oiling, lubing mechanical
 equipment, changing batteries, vacant room checks, and inspecting the interiors and exteriors
 of buildings
- Works as an electrician apprentice on repairing minor electrical problems and installing new equipment
- Provides basic troubleshooting and repair of various residential to light commercial HVAC systems
- Works as a carpenter apprentice in the alteration, repair and maintenance of buildings
- Works as a plumber apprentice on assembling, installing and repairing pipes, fittings and fixtures of heating, water and sewer systems
- Follows appropriate safety procedures when working with moving mechanical parts, chemicals, electricity, aerosols, ladders, paints and in confined spaces
- Uses various hand tools, and power equipment including, but not limited to, saws, drill press, sanding machine, jack hammer, pumps, and tractors
- Maintains tools and machinery in good condition and uses all tools carefully and as trained
- Supports the routine service and maintenance on electric carts
- Works with the Buildings and Grounds team in providing support for various Tenacre events and activities
- Respects and maintains the privacy and confidentiality of both Tenacre's guests and resident staff

Additional Responsibilities and Competencies

- Provides after-hours maintenance support through a weekly rotating schedule with fellow maintenance on-call team members
- Attends training seminars and classes as appropriate
- Ability and willingness to learn the methods and practices used in various skilled trades
- Demonstrated ability to work with hands and to work in mechanically oriented situations following supervisor's instructions
- Ability to work with little or no supervision, given proper instructions.

- Ability to follow written or oral instructions
- Ability to perform strenuous work, in varying weather conditions, with no physical limitations such as bending, stooping, climbing, and walking
- Ability to safely lift objects up to 70lbs by oneself and heavier objects with assistance
- Utilizes office technology skillfully such as phone and paging systems, copiers, computers and software applications such as Excel, Word, Outlook and Internet Explorer
