Summary: Participates in the Mission and Ministry of Tenacre as a manager to:

- Develop and manage a ministry where a team of dedicated Christian Science nurses minister to Church friends for up to two-week periods, while upholding a prayer-filled environment for quick and whole healing.
- Provide Christian Science nursing, along with other Christian Science nurses as needed
- Approach everything from the standpoint of a demonstrable knowledge of Christian Science practice

Essential Duties, Responsibilities and Competencies include the following: (Other duties may be assigned)

To perform this job successfully, an individual should be progressively demonstrating his or her knowledge of the practice of Christian Science as outlined in the *Church Manual of The First Church of Christ, Scientist*, in Boston Massachusetts by Mary Baker Eddy (*Church Manual*).

Manages Holly setting with five private rooms; handles admissions and departures for Church friends and the hiring and departures for Christian Science nurses

Ministers with spiritual poise: Practices spiritual discernment in meeting needs, takes appropriate initiative; acts and speaks in a manner consistent with the highest ethics and integrity; honors and respects each individual Church friend's abilities and practice of Christian Science; alert to giving oneself Christian Science treatment to address any imposition on thought when ministering

Honors the sacred relationship of the practitioner and patient: Remains free from interfering with Practitioner/Patient relationship (See *Church Manual*, p. 46:12-17)

Communicates effectively and with inspiration: Demonstrates the ability to communicate with Church friends, Christian Science practitioners, staff and all with grace and clarity; utilizes office technology skillfully such as phone, copiers, computer, including software programs, such as word processing

Judgment: Makes sound, accurate, and timely decisions; includes appropriate people in decision-making process; can manage and complete paperwork and reports without direct supervision; anticipates and balances ministerial priorities; uses time efficiently

Church-focused: All activities are church-focused, guided by the Glossary definition of Church (*Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures* by Mary Baker Eddy, p. 583)

Qualities: Ministers with patience, persistence, honesty, compassion, humility, good sense of humor, sound morals and unconditional love.

- Satisfactory completion of Christian Science nurse's education
- Experience commensurate with this position to fulfill the requirements in the By-law, "Christian Science nurse", including active *Journal* listing (*Church Manual*, p. 49)
- Fluency and clarity in speaking, reading, and writing English
- Previous well-rounded experience in serving others and discerning and meeting Christian
 Science nursing needs
- Familiar with and dedicated to ministering within the *Christian Science Nurse Scope of Services*, published by The Mother Church.
