- Prays through every aspect of the Instructor role, expressing receptivity and obedience to divine direction and flexibility and spontaneity in the approach to the events of each day
- Works with the School Director and other School team members to develop and refine Christian Science nursing courses, classes, and workshops, brings inspiring, fresh ideas for the content and the current teaching methods and processes
- Plans and facilitates classes utilizing a demonstrated ability in the subject area, as well as excellent organization, communication, and presentation skills
- Participates in Progress Conversations related to essential duties and responsibilities; selfevaluates, solicits feedback from others, and is open to constructive ideas for progress
- Works with the School Director, Assistant Director, and School Instructors and Visiting
 Instructors to lovingly and constructively evaluate staff members at the end of each course; stay
 current with evaluation tools being practiced; maintains School Standards throughout each
 course; collaborates with the Assistant Director and the Director to handle any situations that
 may arise with students

- Collaborates with School team members, Christian Science Nursing Services, and the mentors to provide and/or arrange for educational support agreed upon for students after completion of a course, class, or workshops
- Has the willingness and ability to be flexible with ministry times to meet the needs of the School for classes and mentoring on and off the Tenacre campus
- Participates in enrichment/learning experiences
 - Attends appropriate courses, workshops, conferences
 - Stays up to date with the current practices of Christian Science nurse's education in the Christian Science movement
- Skillfully utilizes office technology, such as the Tenacre phone system, computer, copiers, software for word processing, accessing the Internet, etc.
